# Do You or a Member of Your Family Have a Severe or Developmental Disability?

A severe or developmental disability is defined as a mental or physical impairment likely to continue indefinitely. The impairment results in substantial functional limitations in three or more of the following major life activities: Self-care, receptive and expressive language, learning, mobility, self-direction, capacity for independent living and economic self-sufficiency.

## What Is Family Support?

*The Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (DIDD) Family Support Program is designed to assist individuals with a severe or developmental disability and their families to remain together in their homes and communities. Family Support is funded by state dollars.*



### The primary purpose of the program is to support:

Families with children with severe or developmental disabilities, school age and younger

Adults with severe or developmental disabilities who choose to live with their families

Adults with severe or developmental disabilities who are residing in the community in an unsupported setting (not a state or federally funded program)

A key element of the Family Support Program is family and consumer involvement. Local Councils have been established and meet on a regular basis to oversee the distribution of local services and funds.

### How Can Family Support Help?

Services can include, but are not limited to:

- Respite care
- Personal assistance services
- Before/After Care
- Homemaker services
- Minor home modifications and vehicular modifications
- Specialized equipment maintenance and repair
- Specialized nutrition, clothing and supplies
- Transportation services
- Health-related costs not otherwise covered
- Licensed nursing and nurses aid services
- Family counseling, training and support groups
- Recreation/Summer camp
- Behavior therapy
