MHDS and Men's Wearhouse Challenges West Tennessee Residents to Help Donate 250K Clothing Items
This Year for a Collective ONE MILLION Donations

Jackson, TN - 7-14-15 – MHDS, an agency providing a variety of services to adults with intellectual disabilities, is partnering with Men's Wearhouse to launch its eighth annual National Suit Drive, a six-week initiative that collects donations of gently-used professional attire for unemployed Americans. Clothing collected at Men's Wearhouse stores between June 22nd and July 31st as a result of the drive, will be distributed to MHDS and over 180 local nonprofit organizations that provide job-ready skills, training and seminars to disadvantaged men and women entering or re-entering the workforce in Jackson and across the United States.

"As those we serve seek employment, we focus on their skills as well as their confidence," states William D. Brewer, Jr., Executive Director of MHDS. "The knowledge that they are dressed appropriately can give interviewees the confidence they need to focus on the questions at hand and the National Suit Drive is a wonderful cause that provides needed assistance as we help position our clients to achieve success.")

As part of this year's National Suit Drive, Men's Wearhouse is issuing a challenge to consumers across the country to meet or exceed the goal of 250,000 donated items. Over the past seven years, the National Suit Drive has collected approximately 850,000 professional clothing donations, and this year marks the opportunity to break the one million donation mark.

Since June 22nd, residents of Jackson and West Tennessee have been donating their gently-used professional clothing, including men's and women's suits, ties, jackets, shirts, pants, belts and shoes, at Men's Wearhouse located in The Columns at 1012 Vann Drive. As a thank you, donors will receive 50 percent off the regular retail price of their next purchase from Men's Wearhouse (excluding shoes, clearance and Exceptional Value items).

"The National Suit Drive gives men looking to re-enter the workforce a chance at a new beginning.
